Dear Friends of Bp. Alemany High School:



- **When a student returns from an absence they need to bring a note signed by the parent/ guardian explaining the reason to the Attendance Office.
- **Permission to leave school before the time of dismissal requires a written request from parent or guardian which is presented to Attendance Office before first period of the day.
- **The student will be released only after the written request is authorized.
- **Parent/quardians or authorized persons who come to pick up student must produce proper picture identification.
- **Upon students return they must come to the Attendance office to be readmitted.
